International Journal of Applied and Experimental Biology (IJAEb)

1. **Type of research articles:** International Journal of Applied and Experimental Biology publishes research articles as full-length research articles, short communications, and review articles.
2. **Frequency of publication:** International Journal of Applied and Experimental Biology is bi-annual. First issue is published in January and the second in July each year.
3. **Open access:** All accepted manuscripts are published online as OPEN access. Readers from across the globe can download or print published manuscripts without any charges.
4. **Copyright policy:** The first two volumes of the International Journal of Applied and Experimental Biology were published under the terms of the *Creative Commons Attribution-NonCommercial 4.0 International License* (CC BY-NC 4.0). From January, 2024, IJAEb will be published under *CC Attribution 4.0* (CC BY 4.0). This allows the scientific community to share, reuse, modify or remix the article content in any medium as long as the original source or author is properly cited. 5. **Publication ethics:** International Journal of Applied and Experimental Biology follows a set standards of ethical behavior for authors, editors, reviewers and society sponsoring the research journal as mentioned by the Code of Conduct of the Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE). <https://publicationethics.org/files/2008%20Code%20of%20Conduct.pdf>
6. **Authorship:** Publication of any scientific work in International Journal of Applied and Experimental Biology requires formal Ethical Standards to be followed including authorship. Authors must have contributed substantially to a work, such as conception of idea, designing experiment, data acquisition, data analysis, data interpretation, critical review of the article, final version approval, ensuring the issues related to accuracy or completeness of any part of work.
7. **Contribution of each author with detail:** An author statement should be submitted describing the significant scientific contribution to the research work or contribution in scientific write-up of the manuscript.
8. **Plagiarism and originality:** A manuscript should have less than 15% overall similarity index and less than 5% similarity index from a single source. The submitted manuscripts having similarity index over the values mentioned earlier will be returned to corresponding/submitting authors for revision of the manuscript. 9. **Citation Manipulation:** A submitted manuscript should follow the citation ethics and avoid citations of a given author or from a particular journal.
10. **Peer review policy:** International Journal of Applied and Experimental Biology follows the single blind peer-review procedure for all submitted manuscripts. In this type of peer-reviewing, identity of the reviewers is not disclosed to authors of a submitted manuscript.

- a. All submitted articles to International Journal of Applied and Experimental Biology are assessed at the Editorial Office.
 - b. The Editorial team will check all submitted manuscripts for similarity index using Turnitin software, manuscript formatting, reference format, and necessary file checking (Figures, Tables, Supplementary data), quality of presented work, and also to check whether or not MS lies within the aims and scope of the journal.
 - c. If the submitted manuscript is of poor quality in terms of novelty and originality or do not fall in the scope of the journal, the manuscript will be rejected as “Desk Rejected”.
 - d. If the submitted manuscript meets the criteria of submission, it will undergo an extensive peer review process.
 - e. Editor-in-Chief/Handling Editor/ Editorial Office will assign the manuscript to two independent external referees (one from international scientific community) for peer-review process.
 - f. Submissions from the Editor-in-Chief / Co-Editor/ Editorial Board Members will not be more than 20%. In addition, all such types of submissions will undergo peer-review process through another Editor.
 - g. All manuscripts submitted to International Journal of Applied and Experimental Biology will be processed at the OJS/PKP platform. Based on peer-review reports, one of the journal editors assigned or Editor-in-Chief will take the decision. All the comments/decisions will then be conveyed to the author(s).
 - h. All efforts will be made to expedite the peer review process leading to timely publication.
 - i. The reviewers will evaluate all sections of the MS by giving comments and recommendations as accept as is, revisions required, or reject. Reviewers can also upload review report and suggestions on the manuscript directly on the journal online system as annotated file.
 - j. The manuscript rejected will be closed, while a manuscript with revision required will require a response from authors in another round of review process for re-considering by the Editor.
 - k. The Handling Editor or Production Editor will process the manuscripts for formatting, copy editing, proofreading, and metadata generation for indexing and publication purpose.
 - l. In the accepted manuscripts, digital images such as gel picture will be scrutinized for any indication of manipulation. For verification, the Journal's Editors may ask to the authors for the original data.
11. **Animal and Human Studies:** Manuscripts containing animal or human studies must include statement in Materials and Methods about the approval from Ethics Committee or Review Board.
 12. **Disclosure and conflict of interests:** The submitting author needs to provide a statement to disclose any competing interest or any conflict of interest among the authors or any organization.
 13. **Article processing and publication charges:** To provide open access to all published articles in IJAaEB, this journal has a publication fee (Article publishing charges, APC), which needs to be met by the corresponding author of the articles or his/her research funders. This ensures the free access of article published in IJAaEB to everyone permanently. Corresponding author will pay USD 150 (Effective from 1st January, 2024) as APC when a

manuscript is found suitable for publication after appropriate peer review process. However, there is no fee for submitting the articles.

14. **Corrections and retraction of research articles:** After publishing a manuscript, if any part of text or data is found plagiarized therein, the manuscript will be retracted from the journal website. Before retraction, the Editor-in-Chief of the journal will contact the authors and ask about anomalies in the published manuscript. Upon unsatisfactory response from the authors, the Editor-in-Chief will retract the manuscript with a 'Retraction Note' and weblink to the original article of the plagiarized manuscript.
15. **Principles on research data:** Submitted manuscripts that are found to have either fabricated or falsified experimental results, including the manipulation of images, will incur data fabrication and falsification sanctions.
16. **Violation of publication ethics:** Any violation of publication ethics found in any manuscript, following sanctions will be implemented:
 - a. The submitted manuscript will be rejected immediately.
 - b. All manuscripts submitted to IJAaEB by any of the authors of the infringing manuscript will be rejected. The authors of infringing manuscripts will be black listed/banned to submit the manuscript in IJAaEB for a period of 36 months.
