

## **Licensing Policy**

### **1. Aims and Objectives**

International Journal of Applied and Experimental Biology (IJAEb) is dedicated to disseminating quality research articles in the field of biology, agriculture, health sciences and related interdisciplinary areas. To promote the advancement of scientific knowledge and its access to the global research community, IJAEb has a licensing policy that governs the use, distribution, and reuse of published content.

### **2. Open Access**

IJAEb follows an Open Access (OA) model, which means that all articles published in the journal are freely available to the students and researchers or to global research community as well as general public. This approach eliminates financial barriers such as subscription fee, and promotes unrestricted access to individuals from various backgrounds for scientific findings. This accessibility to scholarly content to scientific community enables researchers, scholars, and students to exchange the ideas and accelerate the scientific process. This OA policy allows the researchers to read, download, copy, distribute, and utilize the published content without any financial barriers.

### **3. Creative Commons License**

To support the principles of Open Access, IJAEb firmly intends to adopt the **Creative Commons Attribution License (CC BY 4.0)** for all published articles. This license grants readers and users of the journal's content specific rights, including the freedom to share the material by copying and redistributing it in any medium or format. Moreover, the scientific community has the freedom to adapt the content by rewriting, paraphrasing, or transforming it for any purpose, including commercial use. By providing these freedoms, IJAEb facilitates and promotes the dissemination of advanced research findings for various purposes.

**Note:** The first two volumes of the International Journal of Applied and Experimental Biology were published under the terms of the Creative Commons Attribution-Non-Commercial 4.0 International License (CC BY-NC 4.0). From January, 2024, IJAEb will be published under CC Attribution 4.0 (CC BY 4.0)

### **4. Author Retention of Copyright**

Authors retain the copyright ownership of their published articles in IJAEb. However, the authors grant the journal a non-exclusive license to publish their work under the terms of the **Creative Commons Attribution License 4.0 (CC BY 4.0)**. This license permits IJAEb to distribute and make the article publicly available while ensuring proper attribution is given to authors.

### **5. Commercial Use**

IJAEb allows to everyone for commercial use of its published content under the **Creative Commons Attribution License 4.0 (CC BY 4.0)**. This allows individuals, organizations, and entities to use the published articles for commercial purposes,

such as reproducing, translating, adapting and incorporation into other works. However, it is important to give proper attribution to its original authors in order to acknowledge their scientific contribution.

## **6. Attribution and Citation**

In order to maintain academic integrity and acknowledge the original scientific work, it is important to provide proper attribution when using content from IJAaEB. This includes accurate citation with authors, title, year of publication, and journal name. By adhering to these requirements, the research community ensures that the contributions of the authors are recognized and credited the intellectual efforts behind the published content.

## **7. Archiving and Preservation**

IJAaEB recognizes the importance of long-term preservation and archiving of scholarly content by taking measures to ensure that all published articles are carefully archived and preserved in appropriate digital repositories or databases.
